This program is the suggested degree plan to follow if a student wishes to seek a professional degree in the field of architecture starting in high school or any other early college program. This program was developed in conjunction with the Texas Society of Architects to create a dual credit pre-architecture program that consists of courses that will introduce students to the architectural professional and transfer into architecture programs at the most universities in Texas. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has adopted a Field of Study in Architecture course curricula for transfer into upper level high education institution architecture programs. This degree plan includes course listings delineated in that Field of Study document in addition to a few technical skill courses applicable to the field.
