

Texas LGBTQIA+ in Architecture **Survey & Town Hall Recap**




Thank you to everyone who participated — our EDI Committee is reviewing survey responses and Town Hall feedback and considering recommendations for the future to better serve all members.


SURVEY DEMOGRAPHICS

- 54.9% | from Austin, Dallas, or Houston










QUESTIONNAIRE
